Georges Duboeuf, France

Vibrant berry and spice aromas; smooth in the mouth with cherry and raspberry flavours.

Santa Alvara Merlot £13.95

Chile

Full of ripe plum and red berry fruit, medium weight and slightly spicy on the palate, and with a generous fruit-filled finish.

Finca La Colonia Malbec £18.95

Argentina

Sweet and spicy aromas, reminiscent of black pepper. Ripe red fruit on the palate, smooth texture and a harmonious finish.

Deakin Estate Shiraz £19.95

Australia

Good punchy shiraz aromas of mulberry and plum, supported by hints of vanilla and coffee oak. The palate is juicy, spicy and satisfying.

Peppoli Chianti Classico £22.95

Italy

Intense red fruit aromas are off set by delicate notes of vanilla and chocolate. Pleasantly lingering with a fresh vibrant feel in the mouth

Coopers Creek Pinot Noir £25.95

New Zealand

Black plums and black cherries on the nose intermingled with subtle French oak and nuances of grilled meat. Rich and firm on the palate with bold, sweet fruit. A core of ripe black cherry lingers on the finish.

Tiramisu XO £7.50

A heavenly mix of Patron XO cafe Tequila with Mozart white and dark chocolate, splash of Tia Maria and dusted with Chocolate.

Raspberry Delight £7.50

A refreshing mix of Stoli Razberi vodka, combined with vanilla syrup and raspberry puree, fresh cranberry juice, with a touch of squeezed orange wedge, dash of vanilla schnapps and French black raspberry liqueur.

La Vanille Mojito £7.50

A modern twist of old times Mojito, created in 2012 by our well experienced mixologists, give up the best of Brugal Anejo Rum mixed with fresh mint leaves, vanilla infused syrup, fresh lime, hint of apple juice and fine touch of ginger beer.

Glories combination of Bombay sapphire gin with elderflower liqueur and apricot brandy, crowned with champagne.

Drivers Favourite

Rosemary £5.50

A cracking combination of fresh orange and cranberry juice mixed up with lychee and rose syrup and glazed with fresh lime.

Grape Infusion £5.50

A refreshing combination of fresh grapes, fresh raspberries, hint of elderflower and fine touch of Cinnamon syrup, cranberry juice and Ginger Ale.

Classic Mojito £6.95

The origins of Mojito are subject to debate; however stories suggest traces to the 16th century drink “El Draque”. Our version consist Brugal Blanco Especial Rum, fresh mint leaves, fresh lime juice, simple syrup and a touch of soda water.

Cosmopolitan £6.95

The very original Cosmo use to be made with gin, however we enjoy the later version by Toby Cecchini, which over time has become something of an international standard. Stolichnaya Citron Vodka, Cointreau, fresh lime, cranberry juice and a touch of simple syrup.

Margarita £6.95

There is no solid proof “who invented” the Margarita. The most accepted of all stories is that the Margarita was invented in October 1941, at Hussong’s Cantina in Ensenada, Mexico by Bartender Don Carlos Orozco. One slow afternoon, Don Carlos was experimenting with mixing Tequila, orange flavoured liqueur, fresh lime and simple syrup to create new drinks when a prestigious visitor arrived. Margarita Henkel, the daughter of German ambassador. Don Carlos offered the drink to Margarita, and named it after her for being the first person to taste it.

Singapore Sling £6.95

Invented around 1915 by Ngiam Tong Bong at Raffles Hotel in Singapore this favourite classic of our consist of Bombay Sapphire Gin, Cherry Liqueur, Benedictine, touch of Pineapple Juice, bitters and fresh Pineapple, topped with Soda.

French 75 £6.95

Originally Called ‘Soixante Quinze’ and said to be invented at Harry’s New York Bar in Paris, named after French artillery piece. Tanqueray Gin shaken with fresh lemon juice and sugar, topped up with Champagne.

Old Fashioned £6.95

First written mention of a word cocktail comes from morning post and gazetteer, 1798, London. We stick to definition of cocktail from 1806. Makers Mark, sugar cube, cherry, and orange slice and bitters, however feel free to ask your bartender should you prefer spirit of any other kind.

Vesper Martini £7.95

The drink was invested and named by fictional secret and James Bond in the 1953 novel Casino Royale. Our recreation of it is three measures of Bombay Sapphire Gin, Stolichnaya Vodka, and dash of Lillet Blanc. Shakenuntil its ice cold, then fine strained in to pre chilled martini glass with lemon twist.

Siete Soles Sauvignon Blanc £13.95

Chile

Intense, fresh aromas of green fruit, grapefruit, lime, nectarines, peach and acacia flowers. Crisp and lively on the palate with a fresh aftertaste.

Tamarind Garden Chardonnay/Gewürztraminer £16.95

Chile

This white wine combines the weight and ripeness of the Chardonnay with a small amount of spicier Gewürztraminer to underpin the milder aromatic flavours of Indian cuisine.

Terre del Noce Pinot Grigio £4.95 £5.95 £17.95

Italy

Elegant, dry Pinot Grigio with apple and banana fruit aromas, floral lift in the mouth, and a clean, crisp finish.

Deakin Estate Chardonnay £19.95

Australia

This Chardonnay shows aromas of ripe pear, nectarine and apple. The palate is ripe and smooth with delicious fruit character without being over the top.

Chablis Domaine Hamelin £25.95

France

Fresh, classic nose with notes of green apple, hawthorn and minerals. Crisp on the palate while displaying good depth of flavour, and a long dynamic finish.
